Segregation. Laws to sperate white and black people in public and private facilities. Grandfather Clause. To reinstate white voter who may have failed the literacy test or could not pay the poll tax, several Southern states added the grandfather clause which states that even if a man failed the literacy test or could not afford the poll tax, he was still entitled to a vote if he, his father, or his grandfather had been eligible to vote before January 1, 1867.
