Cirrhosis is a complication of many liver diseases characterized by abnormal structure and function of the liver. The diseases that lead to cirrhosis do so because they injure and kill liver cells, after which the inflammation and repair that is associated with the dying liver cells causes scar tissue to form.

Cirrhosis, also known as liver cirrhosis or hepatic cirrhosis, is a condition in which the liver does not function properly due to long-term damage. This damage is characterized by the replacement of normal liver tissue by scar tissue. Typically, the disease develops slowly over months or years. Early on, there are often no symptoms.

Cirrhosis of the liver This is the term used to describe liver disease where chronic inflammation of liver cells has caused an extensive

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and widespread build up of scar tissue in the liver. Scar tissue is similar to collagen, as it is tough fibrous tissue, which replaces damaged liver cells.

Cirrhosis of liver is a critical condition of the liver that is on-going and long term. In this condition, the islands of liver tissue replace the normal structure of the liver. This occurs because scar tissues, which are non-functional, separate the liver tissues and thus, creates the islands of scar tissue within normal liver.

Cirrhosis is scarring of the liver caused by continuous, long-term liver damage. Scar tissue replaces healthy tissue in the liver and prevents the liver from working properly. The damage caused by cirrhosis can't be reversed and can eventually become so extensive that your liver stops functioning. This is called liver failure.

Cirrhosis develops progressively as a result of damage to the liver (which can be due to a number of causes), usually over a number of years. The normal smooth liver structure becomes distorted, with nodules surrounded by fibrosis. This affects the liver's synthetic, metabolic and excretory actions. Cirrhosis can be described as:

Liver injury that results in cirrhosis also may be caused by a number of inherited diseases such as cystic fibrosis, alpha-1 antitrypsin deficiency, hemochromatosis, Wilson's disease, galactosemia, and

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glycogen storage diseases. Two inherited disorders result in the abnormal storage of metals in the liver leading to tissue damage and cirrhosis.

The liver becomes inflamed, starting the long process of cell damage that leads to cirrhosis. Children may be born with a condition that blocks the bile ducts called biliary atresia. Cirrhosis is a condition of diffuse hepatic fibrosis with replacement of the normal liver architecture by nodules. It is the final pathway for a wide variety of chronic liver diseases. Progression of chronic liver disease to cirrhosis can take anywhere from weeks to years, depending on the disease etiology.

Liver cirrhosis can usually regrow cells after tissue damage. This condition happens when various factors that damage the liver like infections and alcohol exist long-term. When the liver can't function properly due to scarring it could progress into cirrhosis. When the liver experiences this results in the organ shrinking/hardening.

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
