Clinical symptoms such as depression, inappetence, colic and fever can occur post-castration which might be related to one of the common complications. Most of the listed complications below are predominantly related to open castration with closed castration or open castration under general anaesthesia (which has a 0.9% chance of mortality due to anaesthetic risks)

Castration | Scott Dunn's Equine Clinic

Inguinal: This is the classical approach because it is less painful, does not scar the scrotum, and heals quickest (3 to 5 weeks). Your surgeon makes a Kelâmi incision about 4 inches (10 cm) long across your lower abdomen. The surgeon gently pushes the testicle up through the inguinal canal in your pelvis and through the incision.

Although androgen-deprivation therapy (ADT) remains the mainstay of castration-sensitive prostate cancer (CSPC) therapy, the disease's heterogeneity and the limited duration of the response have chaperoned the introduction of chemotherapy and the investigation of novel hormonal targeted agents in this setting.

Cryptorchid Castration - Approach. Cryptorchid testis being removed Inguinal or pre-scrotal testes are removed using a typical castration incision or by incising directly over the retained testis if it's location is far from the standard midline incision. A parapreputial skin and paramedian abdominal wall incision is often used for removal of abdominal testes in dogs.

New Approaches to Immunotherapy for Metastatic Castration ...

Typical equine doses of alpha-2 agonists work for donkeys, but be prepared to increase the dose if the donkey is stressed and do not induce anaesthesia until the head has dropped below the withers. Ketamine at a dose of 2.2–3 mg/kg is typically used together with diazepam at 0.1 mg/kg for induction.
