Endoscopic techniques for carpal tunnel release involve one or two smaller incisions through which instrumentation is introduced including a synovial elevator, probes, knives, and an endoscope used to visualize the underside of the transverse carpal ligament. Carpal tunnel is the most common peripheral compressive neuropathy. Nonoperative management may provide temporary alleviation of symptoms, but in most cases surgical decompression is warranted. There are a multitude of approaches ranging from open release under general anesthesia to wide awake in-office endoscopic carpal tunnel release.

Endoscopic Carpal Tunnel Release: Indications, Technique ...

The controversy has grown since the advent of endoscopic carpal tunnel surgery. Previously, your only option was open carpal tunnel release surgery. In open release, surgeons cut your palm to expose the transverse carpal tunnel ligament in order to sever it in half. Using the new technology, surgeons make one or two small incisions in the hand.

Pros & Cons of Endoscopic Surgery for Carpal Tunnel

While the most common surgical procedure for a carpal tunnel release is still the open-incision technique, some surgeons are using a new procedure, called endoscopic carpal tunnel release. The procedure is done using an endoscope (a small, fiber-optic TV camera) to look into the carpal tunnel through a small incision just below the wrist.

In recent years, many surgeons have turned to endoscopic carpal tunnel release as an alternative to traditional open surgery, which has been shown to require shorter recovery times and allow people to return to work sooner. This is not to suggest that endoscopic surgery is "better" than open surgery.

Carpal Tunnel Surgery: Preparation, Recovery, Long-Term Care

In an endoscopic carpal tunnel release, the doctor makes 2, half-inch incisions. One is on the wrist, and one is on the palm. Then he or she inserts a camera attached to a narrow tube into one incision. The camera guides your doctor as he or she inserts the instruments and cuts the carpal ligament through the other incision.

First introduced in 1989 by Okutsu et al, endoscopic carpal tunnel release has undergone close scrutiny and evolved from a two port method with poorer outcomes to a safe technique through the one portal Agee protocol. It remains a safe option in the hands of an experienced surgeon.

Endoscopic Carpal Tunnel Release - CSurgeries

Endoscopic carpal tunnel release uses one or two small incisions near the wrist through which instruments are inserted. A small camera is used to visualize the inner wrist, specifically the transverse carpal ligament (roof of the carpal tunnel).

Carpal Tunnel Syndrome | MEDcraze

During endoscopic carpal tunnel release surgery, the transverse carpal ligament is cut, releasing pressure on the median nerve, relieving the symptoms of carpal tunnel syndrome. The small incision in the palm is closed with stitches.
