As the benefit level that can be informally enforced by the family falls, it may become optimal for the state to intervene and take over responsibility for social insurance provision from the family. But if strong family ties exist naturally, the state's best response is to keep these ties (with the associated gains from monitoring of individual behaviour by peers) and opt out of welfare provision altogether.

Dismantling the welfare state means transferring as much as possible of the costs of reproducing the labour force from society to individual family units, and within them women.
