As Hong Kong enters its third year under Chinese rule, the prognosis for the common law remains uncertain. Can the improbable doctrine of ‘one country, two systems’ be made to work? The purpose of this book is to introduce the reader to the law of agency and partnership, as well as company law. It assumes that the reader is familiar in outline with the Hong Kong legal system and knows something about the law of contract. It is one of a series published by the Hong Kong University Press under the general editorship of Professor Derek Roebuck to provide accounting students with an introduction to Hong Kong law.

In China, on the other hand, a completely new system has been created in the last twenty years which, whilst it has various problems and defects, has some notable advantages over the common law equivalent found in Hong Kong.
