The Sveshnikov Variation has become very popular in master level chess. Black's ...e5 push seems anti-positional: it has made the d6-pawn backward and the d5-square weak. However, in return, Black gets a foothold in the centre and gains time on White's knight, which has been driven to the edge of the board on a3.

This variation was present from the beginning of the 1950s and was previously called the Pelican, but it was Evgeny Sveshnikov and Gennadi Timoshchenko who made ground breaking developments in this line and converted it from an upstart to a serious option for Black.

Kalashnikov Variation A completely new development of the whole system was initiated in 1987, when Evgeny Sveshnikov, the godfather of the Sveshnikov Sicilian (4...Nf6 5.Nc3 e5), changed to 4...e5 and followed this with 5...d6, which is positionally more sound. The Kalashnikov system or the Neo-Sveshnikov was born.

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
