Both conditions involve social maturity, physical and emotional development, and cognitive abilities. They also differ in how they are diagnosed and how they are treated.

The two most common co-morbidities were autistic spectrum disorders (33% in mental retardation and 19% in developmental delay) and discrepant language delay (17% in mental retardation and 47% in developmental delay).
